Aztecs Notes

Let's Ride

San Diego State and Wyoming have played 27 times, all during the Mountain West era, with 18 Aztec victories and two ties. SDSU is 13-4-1 vs. the Cowgirls in the Mike Friesen era and 5-5-2 when playing in Laramie. The Aztecs have a total of 15 wins in the last 20 meetings. The teams played last year in San Diego, with SDSU lighting up the scoreboard in a 5-1 victory.

The Aztecs and Rams have met on 11 occasions, all since 2013, and SDSU is 8-1-2. San Diego State holds a 4-1 record when playing on the SDSU Sports Deck. In the team's two matchups last season, SDSU won 3-2 in Fort Collins during the regular seasons and the teams played to a 2-2 draw in the Mountain West Tournament.

Shortening the Match

San Diego State has won 17 straight matches when leading at halftime.

Like Mike

Friesen's 192 victories (192-121-47) since the start of the 2007 season, the year he took control of the program, are the most by any coach in MW history after passing Brigham Young coach Jennifer Rockwood's 190 while the Cougars were in the Mountain West. Boise State's Jim Thomas' 125 victories rank second among current MW head coaches.

Goalkeeper Alexa Madueno leads the Mountain West with 78 saves and is second with 4.88 saves per game and third with a .743 save%. She is 42nd nationally in saves, 73rd in saves per game and 86th in shutouts. Madueno owns the program records for saves (386) and shutouts (27) while ranking eighth in goals against average (8th, 1.36). Among active DI players, she ranks fourth in saves, is tied for 16th in shutouts and is fifth in goalkeeper minutes.

Above the Rest

SDSU holds a lead in the all-time series against every current MW member. The records: AFA (24-1-2, .926), Nevada (14-2-0, .875), CSU (8-1-2, .818), SISU (16-2-4, .818), USU (9-1-4, .786), Fresno State (16-5-2, .739), Wyoming (18-7-2, .704), UNLV (21-10-2, .667), Colorado College (7-3-5, .633), Boise State (11-9-0, .550) and UNM (14-11-8, .545).

Home Cooking
San Diego State is 4-0 in home MW matches. In the first week of play, the team beat Nevada 5-0 and UNLV 2-0 while
Denise Castro won Offensive Player of the Week for three goals, Alexa Madueno earned defensive honors with two shutouts and Mia Lane garnered freshman accolades for a goal and an assist. In SDSU's return home, it took down San Jose State 2-1 and Fresno State 4-0.

Soaring Past the Eagles
SDSU broke out for four goals in its win over Eastern Washington on Sept. 15. Alexyz Nakamoto scored her first career goal, Emma Gaines-Ramos added her team-leading third of the season and Denise Castro had two goals and an assist to tie for the team lead with three goals and take the lead in points with seven.

On the Board

The Scarlet and Black were able to score a goal against two of the top squads in the country during a stretch of three consecutive matches against ranked opponents (the first time SDSU played three straight ranked teams in the MW era (since 1999)) with Kali Trevithick scoring against Stanford and Emma Gaines-Ramos scoring at Texas.

Meep Meep

San Diego State opened 2024 with a 3-0 win over Cal State Bakersfield. Denise Castro, Emma Gaines-Ramos and Olivia Sekimoto each scored while Carlin Blake and Kali Trevithick picked up assists. Alexa Madueno earned her 23rd career shutout and third in three matches at Snapdragon Stadium.

New Kids on the Block

Alexyz Nakamoto scored against Eastern Washington, becoming the first Aztec freshman to score a goal since Logan Nidy in 2022. She scored again in her next match against Utah Valley. Mia Lane followed it up with a goal of her own as well as an assist vs. Nevada, making the duo the first pair of Aztec freshmen to score in the same season since Denise Castro and Alexys Ocampo in 2021.

Castronaut

Last season's leader in goals, assists and points, midfielder Denise Castro is on top of the team leaderboards in goals (8) and points (17) again this season. Castro is tied for the most goals and goals per game (0.50) in the MW as well as third most points and fifth in points per game (1.06) while ranking 61st in the nation in goals and 74th in goals per game. She scored her first goal of 2024 in the season opener against Cal State Bakersfield before a five point performance with a brace and an assist vs. EWU. To begin conference play, Castro had another brace vs. Nevada and an additional goal against UNLV. She scored in consecutive wins over San Jose State and Fresno State. Castro ranks fourth in points (78) and goals (33) in program history.

All About the Gain(e)s(-Ramos)
Forward Emma Gaines-Ramos also scored in the season opener and at Texas, the first goal allowed at home by the Longhorns in 2024. She struck once more vs. Eastern Washington. Gaines-Ramos had two assists against both Nevada and UNLV. Gaines-Ramos scored again at Utah State. She tallied three points with her fifth goal and team leading fifth assist vs. Fresno State. She is tied for fourth in the MW in assists (5), fifth in assists per game (0.33) and is seventh in points per game (1.00).

Kali Living

Forward Kali Trevithick is tied for fourth in points and assists on the Aztec roster. She had an assist against Cal State Bakersfield when she passed to Castro for her goal. Trevithick scored her first goal of the season on a penalty kick vs. Stanford. She followed it up with another assist at Texas. She also had the game winner against Fresno State.

A Historic Goal

Trevithick's goal was the first time the Aztecs scored against Stanford in their last three matches and sixth total San Diego State goal in the Teams' 11 meetings. The last time SDSU got on the board against the Cardinal was on August 30, 2009, in a 5-2 defeat. In addition, Trevithick scored the first San Diego State goal against Stanford in the fourth meeting in San Diego. The goal also marked the Aztecs' second goal in four matches against top two-ranked teams in the Mountain West era (since 1999).

Midfielder Olivia Sekimoto wasted no time in getting going in the season opener. In just the 14th minute of the Aztec season, Sekimoto scored her first goal and the game winner against the Roadrunners. Sekimoto picked up her first assist at Texas.

Coker Classic

Defender Trinity Coker scored her first two goals of the season to begin Mountain West competition. After getting on the board against Nevada for her first goal since playing the Wolf Pack last season, Coker followed it up with the game-winner late in the team's next match against UNLV. She added two more points with assists at Air Force and vs. San Jose State.

Midfielder Carlin Blake is second on the team lead with four assists. Blake assisted on Sekimoto's game winner against Cal State Bakersfield and Goins' first career goal against Weber State before a two assist performance against Eastern Washington. She is tied for seventh in the Mountain West in assists. Blake scored vs. Utah Valley and Fresno State.

Got My Eye On You

Three Azfecs (Denise Castro, Emma Gaines-Ramos and Grace Goins) were named to the Mountain West Preseason Watch List.

Pacific Top 10

The Aztecs have been ranked in the top ten in the Pacific Region by United Soccer Coaches three times this season.

Run it Back

SDSU brings back ten starters from last season's Mountain West champions, including their top two goal scorers in Dori Savage and Denise Castro who scored six and ten goals, respectively.

Back in (Scarlet and) Black
San Diego State returns six of seven All-Mountain West players from last season. Denise Castro was named the Mountain West Offensive Player of the Year and First Team All-Conference while returners Alexa Madueno, Alexys Ocampo and Olivia Sekimoto joined her on the first team. Emma Gaines-Ramos and Grace Goins earned spots on the All-Conference Second Team while All-MW First Team member Kiera Utush graduated and is the lone Aztec representative not to return this fall.

At The Peak

The Aztecs finished 9-1-1 in Mountain West play last season to take home their 12th Mountain West championship and 11th since Mike Friesen took over head coaching duties in 2007.

Hold On, We're Going Home
After bringing home last year's Mountain West regular season title, San Diego State will host this season's Mountain West tournament at the Sports Deck, Quarterfinal matches will take place on Sunday, November 3, semifinal matches will occur on Wednesday, November 6 and the final is on Saturday, November 9.

Iron Mike

Head Coach Mike Friesen is in his 18th campaign leading the Mountain West's most successful women's soccer program. Friesen has guided his squad to 11 Mountain West championships (five tournament and six regular season), and five NCAA Tournament appearances, both the most among any current league head coach. Now in his 18th season of conference play, Friesen has an 111-37-21 record. His 111 league victories are the most by any head coach in Mountain West history.

Past the Century Mark
After last week's action, Friesen is up to 111 career regular season Mountain West wins at the helm of San Diego State women's soccer. The 18-year MW veteran head coach is the only coach in conference history to reach the 100 Mountain West wins plateau. The closest to his mark is Boise State's Jim Thomas, who has 71 conference wins.

Looking into the Crystal Ball
San Diego State is picked to finish in first place in the MW coaches' preseason poll. This marks the 14th time in 15 seasons the Aztecs have been picked to finish in either first or second place. The only time SDSU was lower than second place in the preseason poll in the last 15 years was in 2019, a year in which the Aztecs were predicted to finish fourth. That team went 10-9-1, shared the Mountain West regular-season title at 8-2-0, and reached the championship match of the league tournament.

Best in the (Mountain) West

The Aztecs have won ten of the last 23 MW trophies (regular season and tournament), all of which have come under the direction of head coach Mike Friesen. In total, the 18th-year head coach has guided San Diego State to 11 conference titles.

Top of the Mountain (West)

San Diego State has earned 12 Mountain West titles since the conference's inception in 1999. SDSU was the regular season champions in 1999, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2019 and 2023. The program was the tournament champion in 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2017. The Aztecs' lead all current teams in each category and have the most regular season titles while trailing only Brigham Young (7 tournament titles, 13 overall) in all-time titles.
