SAN DIEGO STATE RETURNS TO ACTION AT KANSAS STATE

 After a weekend off from meet competition, the Aztecs resume their indoor schedule at the DeLoss Dodds Invitational hosted by Kansas State this weekend.

• The Aztecs will send 18 student-athletes, totaling 34 entries for the weekend.

 Last time the Scarlet and Black competed was at the UW Invite/Mile City in Seattle, Wash. two weeks ago. At that meet, six Aztecs combined for eight program top ten marks in the mid-distance and distance events.

 Most notable from the weekend in the pacific northwest was Lauren Harper who earned Mountain West Track Athlete of the Week. The senior set a senior class record in the 800m on Friday before winning the open section mile with the fourth fastest time in SDSU history on Saturday.

• The Aztecs have won a weekly award each week they have competed in a meet this season. Among the teams SDSU will compete against are No. 9 Oklahoma, No. 15 Baylor, Oklahoma

State, Notre Dame, Wichita State, South Dakota, Northern Iowa and the hosts Kansas State.

 Among the Aztecs competing this weekend, indoor 400m school record holder Shaquena Foote will run her first 400m race of the season as well as looking to improve on her nationally ranked 200m time. Similarly, second team all-American triple jumper Xiamara Young will participate in her first triple jump of the season in the meet. Jenna Fee Feyerabend is also set for her first official pentathlon since earning second team all-American honors at the 2023 NCAA Indoor Championships.

 Head Coach Shelia Burrell is in her 16th season at the helm of the program. Since taking over, SDSU has finished top three at the MW championships every year except one, including winning the title in 2013.

 The Aztecs finished second in the Mountain West Indoor Championships last year, their third runner-up finish in the last four conference championship meets.

• Eight Aztecs earned all-Mountain West honors last year, their fourth consecutive season of at least seven honorees. Of the eight, six return for the 2025 season including gold medal winners Hannah Waller (60m) and Shaquena Foote (400m).

• Last year, SDSU had 22 marks etched into the indoor record books, including four school records. This year, the Aztecs have already recorded 11 more program top ten marks.

THE NATIONAL STAGE

Since Shelia Burrell took over the program, the Aztecs have been regulars at the NCAA Indoor Championships. Since 2010, SDSU ranks second in the conference in national indoor championship qualifiers among the conference.

MW ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

Lauren Harper had a record-filled weekend in Seattle, earning Mountain West Women's Track Athlete of the Week for the first time in her career. She began the UW Invite in the 800m run on Friday setting a SDSU senior class record with a 2:09.43, the fastest in the conference this season. The Weaverville native followed it up with a victory in the open section of Mile City. Her time of 4:55.33 is the fourth fastest in program history and ranks fifth in the MW this season.

A SPEEDY MILE CITY

San Diego State competed at the University of Washington's Mile City event on Jan. 18, 2025 and made it one of their fastest meets in program history. Six distance runners ran in the mile - four in the open section, two in the invite - and all six posted a top 15 time in SDSU's indoor history. As mentioned, Harper won the open section with the fourth fastest time in program history. Isabella Fauria (4:57.90) ran the fifth fastest time, Emily Van Valkenburg (5:02.81) ran the seventh fastest and Vanessa Cabello (5:05.33) ran the ninth fastest. Just outside the top ten, Samantha Wood's 5:07.96 ranks 11th and Sara Jones' 5:08.32 is 13th.

AZTEC ALL-AMERICANS

Among the returners for the 2025 season include a pair of indoor All-American performers. Xiamara Young garnered the award finishing ninth in triple jump at last year's NCAA Indoor Championship meet capping off an incredible first career indoor season. Jenna Fee Feyerabend redshirted during indoor a year ago, but was an All-American in 2023 finishing ninth place in the pentathlon.

LEAPING INTO THE RECORD BOOK

Speaking of Xiamara Young, she had an incredible first career indoor season last year. After transferring in from Fresno Pacific where she earned PacWest Freshman of the Year, she entered the record books for both long jump and triple jump in both indoor and outdoor seasons. An indoor All-American and an outdoor honorable mention, her indoor triple jump of 44-0.5 ranked third in the West Region last season and her 20-3.5 in long jump was ninth.

FLEET OF FOOTE

Shaquena Foote is the most decorated athlete on the 2025 roster and owns 13 marks in the record books. During last year's indoor season she broke the 400m school record, which had stood untouched for two decades, in the first meet of the season. She preceded to then break her own record three more times capped off with a gold medal at the MW Indoor Championships. One of the fastest sprinters in the West, she owns the second fastest 200m time in the region (tied for 10th nationally) and ranks just outside the top ten in the 60m.

DUAL THREAT

Senior Hannah Waller proved to be one of the best athletes in the West Region last year, finishing her 2024 indoor season with the second best 60m time in the region (7.24aa), fifth best long jump mark (20-6.5) and sixth best 200m time (23.24aa). Going into her second meet of the season, she ranks tenth in the region in the 60m and tied for 17th in long jump.

AJI ACCELERATES

Aji Mbye came to San Diego State from The Gambia last year and wasted no time etching her name into the record books. Earning all-Mountain West in the indoor 60m and outdoor 100m, she set four SDSU freshman records between indoor and outdoor, and ranks in the all-time top ten six different times. Among freshmen in the West Region, she ranked second in the 200m and third in the 60m during indoor season last year. In her one race this year, she has already improved on her record-filled first year with a PR in the 60m (7.38aa) that ranks 14th in the West Region and makes her seventh in SDSU history.

THE HURDLING DUO

Charlize James and Jada Pierre finished one-two in their heat at the MW Indoor Championships last year and both scored points toward the Aztecs' team total. Two of the top hurdlers in the conference and west region got off to a quick start this year, finishing as the top two collegiate runners in the event at the season opening meet. James (8.42aa) and Pierre (8.43aa) currently rank second and third in the Mountain West and 14th and 15th in the West region.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS

The Aztecs welcome six new faces for the 2025 season, four of which made their collegiate debuts in the season opener. Peyton Bedrosianc cleared 3.75m (12-3.5) in pole vault, Mikaela Warr ran a 7.50aa in the 60m, Pavana Nagaraj leapt 5.79m (19-0) in long jump and Laraigh Allen ran a 24.98aa in the 200m. Sara Jones became the fifth of the group making her indoor debut at Washington, running a 2:21.52 in the 800m and a 5:08.32 in the mile.

THE USTFCCCA RANKINGS

The first rankings of the season from the United States Track and Field and Cross Country Associaton were released on Tuesday and the Aztecs find themselves at No. 75 nationally, No. 16 in the west and fourth in the Mountain West. In the outlet's event rankings, SDSU is No. 11 in the nation in the 60m, No. 18 in the 60m hurdles, No. 38 in the 200m, No. 42 in long jump and No. 44 in the 800m.

Shelia Burrell, a two-time Olympian in the heptathlon, enters her 16th season as the head track and field coach at San Diego State.

While at San Diego State, she has coached four NCAA individual champions, 67 All-Americans, 81 Mountain West individual champions, 15 MW relay champions and 244 all-MW performances. Additionally, she has seen over 60 school records set under her watch.

Under her guidance, the Aztecs have finished first or second in the Mountain West Outdoor Championships in 10 of their last 11 meets, including six league titles - 2013, 2014, 2017, 2018, 2021 and 2022. SDSU has also finished among the Mountain West's top three teams in 12 of additional the league titles - 2013, 2014, 2017, 2018, 2021 and 2022. SDSU has also finished among the Mountain West's top three teams in 12 of

their 14 indoor championships, including the league title in 2013.

A six-time Mountain West Coach of the Year recipient, she has also garnered regional honors as well being selected as the 2013 West Region Indoor Head Coach of the Year and the 2019 West Region Outdoor Coach of the Year awards from the USTFCCCA. During the 2013 indoor season, Burrell coached the NCAA outdoor national triple jump runner-up Shanieka Thomas (Ricketts), six Mountain West champions, 14 all-conference performers and won the conference title. During the 2019 outdoor season, her team totaled five all-America honors, 10 regional qualifying entries, two MW champions and 15 all-conference performers.

ALRICK MUNROE Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator

Alrick Munroe joined the Aztec coaching staff in the 2013-14 season as a volunteer and was promoted to assistant coach in 2018. He coaches the long sprints, long hurdles and the 800-meter run.

With over 20 years of track and field coaching experience, Munroe has helped San Diego State win five Mountain West team titles, accomplish numerous school records and produce multiple All-Americans. Under Munroe's direction, the Aztecs have sent four 4x400m relay teams to the NCAA Championships since 2018. Prior to that, SDSU had not sent a 4x4 squad to the NCAAs since 2006.

Since 2018, he has overseen four NCAA Outdoor Championship qualifiers, 15 NCAA preliminary qualifiers, 10 outdoor MW event titles and four indoor MW event titles. Further, SDSU's 4x400m relay teams have won gold at every conference championship and qualified for every NCAA West Prelim since his promotion to full-time assistant coach.

ROBERT LUSITANA

Assistant Coach/Head Cross Country Coach

San Diego State alum, Robert Lusitana, is in his eighth year as a member of the San Diego State track and field/cross country program coaching staff as the distance and head cross country coach.

In his seven completed years, Lusitana's distance runners have posted four NCAA Regional qualifying marks and four all-conference performances. The Aztecs had totaled five qualifiers and two all-conference performers in the 17 years prior to his arrival.

The cross country team has also enjoyed a tremendous turnaround over the last two years highlighted by their highest placement at an NCAA West Regional meet since 2005 and second-best finish since the race became a 6K. Since 2017, the Aztecs have recorded theis seven fastest team times, and 11 of their top 12. In 2024, they also recorded the program's first ever 6K team victory.

RICHARD FOX Assistant Coach

Richard Fox enters his 30th season as an assistant coach at San Diego State. In 1996, Fox became a member of the Aztec staff as a volunteer coach knowing the NCAA was going to implement the pole vault for women in 1998. Since then, Fox has brought SDSU to the forefront in collegiate pole-vaulting as one of the nation's premier programs.

In his tenure, Fox has mentored 21 All-American honorees earned by seven different vaulters, including four NCAA runner-ups. His vaulters have totaled 23 appearances in the NCAA finals and 75 provisional qualifiers. Further, between indoor and outdoor seasons, he has coached 30 Mountain West champions, 22 MW runner-ups and 128 all-conference performers.

Fox has served as the coach of all 22 of SDSU's top indoor pole vault marks and all 20 of its top outdoor pole vault marks.
