Big Notes

- The Aztecs still finished with 25 victories this season, their most since winning a school-record 27 in 2012-13.
- SDSU has six seasons with at least 25 victories (also 1980-81, 1988-89, 1993-94, 2011-12 and 2012-13).
- San Diego State's 70 victories over the last three seasons match its most in a three-season span in school history (also 1993-94, 1994-95 and 1995-96).
- The Aztecs saw their eight-game winning streak snapped and finished the season winning 11 of their final 14.

NCAA Tournament Notes

- San Diego State plays in its first NCAA Tournament since 2012.
- The Aztecs fall to 6-10 all-time in NCAA Tournament games.
- SDSU is now 2-4 all-time in NCAA Tournament road games.
- San Diego State drops to 5-5 in NCAA First Round games.
- The Aztecs drop to 2-1 against the No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament.
- SDSU is 0-1 all-time in the NCAA Tournament as a No. 14 seed.
- San Diego State drops to 0-3 all-time in the state of Louisiana in the NCAA Tournament (0-2 at LSU, 0-1 at Louisiana Tech).

Series Notes

• San Diego State falls to 0-2 all-time against LSU with both games being played in Baton Rouge in the NCAA Tournament.

Team Notes

- SDSU fell to 10-4 on the road this season.
- San Diego State fell to 11-4 in night games (5 p.m. or later).
- The Aztecs fell to 9-9 when trailing at the end of the first quarter.

- SDSU dropped to 5-9 when trailing at halftime.
- SDSU fell to 4-10 when trailing at the end of the third quarter.
- San Diego State allowed a season-high 103 points, the most by an opponent since UCLA scored 104 on Dec. 11, 1998.

- LSU made its first two shots, both three-pointers.
- LSU opened the game on an 11-0 run before a Nat Martinez three-pointer got SDSU on the scoreboard 3:32 into the game.

- San Diego State's first substitution of the second half was Jazlen Green in for Adryana Quezada 2:58 in.
